RESOLUTION NO. 2506

RE: Approving the Final Local Solid Waste Management Plan

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (the "Agency") is engaged in Solid Waste Management and Recycling in Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the LSWMP is administered in Ulster County by the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency which was formed in 1986 for the purpose of developing, financing, and implementing a comprehensive countywide solid waste management plan, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (the "Agency") is responsible for the creation of the Local Solid Waste Management Plan (LSWMP) for the County, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) requires each County to submit a ten year plan program for approval by the NYSDEC, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency prepared a Draft LSWMP for the 10-year period from 2020 through 2029, and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) has given its approval by letter dated May 1, 2020 , and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Environmental requires that the Agency submit 1. A complete, stand-alone final LSWMP which contains all revisions of the draft LSWMP resulting from department review and 2. As required by 6 NYCRR 366-4.1, a certified resolution from the Ulster County Legislature stating; 1) that the LSWMP is adopted by the UCRRA Board of Directors and the Ulster County Legislature; 2) that UCRRA will implement and maintain the solid waste management system as described in the final LSWMP and 3) that UCRRA will submit biennial updates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency does hereby approve the Final LSWMMP and shall adopt it as its Final LSWMP, and be it further,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Agency is hereby authorized to submit the Final LSWMP to the Ulster County Legislature for its approval Resolution, as required by 6 NYCRR 366-4.1, and be it further

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

On April 27, 2020, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) issued a letter of findings addressed to the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (UCRRA) related to the Ulster County (County) draft Local Solid Waste Management Plan (LSWMP). On April 28, 2020, the Department received your request to revise references in the certified resolutions mentioned in that letter. Therefore, this letter supersedes and replaces the letter issued to UCCRA on April 27.
