## FEBRUARY 2023 RECYCLING PROGRAM UPDATE

#### **NARRATIVE**

Mr. Ollivier asked that I provide a narrative to accompany the Recycling Program Update. I look forward to your feedback about this format and would like to note that examples of our program media are always available by request.

January and February are our busiest times of the year in terms of administrative tasks, so this has been our primary focus this month. NYSDEC reports are due which disclose the weight of all materials recovered, recycled, or disposed in the previous year. Per Margot Becker's request, a summary of Agency waste diversion and recycling practices has been added to our website as a new blog article this month to share the Agency's many successes in these areas.

Coordination of the Ulster County Annual Waste & Recycling Report is another ongoing task in the first quarter of the year. A total of 305 facilities (public and private) are being surveyed this year. Each report is meticulously tracked, analyzed, input into a matrix to calculate an estimate for the total waste stream in Ulster County. An Executive Summary will become available later this year. Requirements for this report are in accordance with the Ulster County Mandatory Source Separation Law, and the Agency's Local Solid Waste Management Plan.

Please refer to our Recycling Program Update for more details about our outreach and community engagement strategies and events this month – noting several partnerships with local libraries, Repair Cafes, and community centers. I'd like to note a special OTT Digital Advertising Campaign has yielded 122,227 impressions (views) and a special Youtube Pre-Roll Advertising Campaign yielded 27,674 impressions and 120 hours of watch time so far this month. The Recycling Outreach Team continues to plan and strategize advertising and outreach efforts for the Spring and we're currently coordinating sixteen more program requests and several Agency sponsored programs for Spring 2023.
