Kingston Organics: Phase 1: Community Food Scrap Drop Off

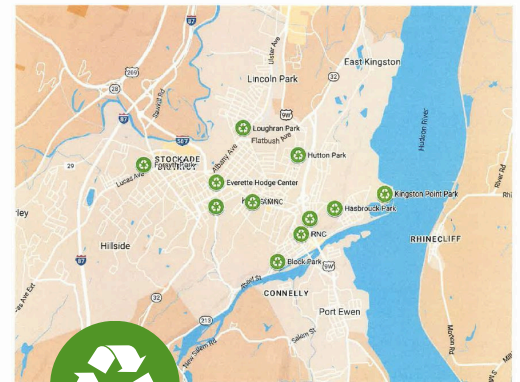
