

**ULSTER COUNTY RESOURCE RECOVERY AGENCY**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2671**

**RE: Amending 2026 Tipping Fee for Municipal Sewage Sludge**

**WHEREAS**, the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (the "Agency") approved a fee schedule for 2026, that kept municipal customers at 135 dollars per ton for municipal solid waste, construction and demolition debris and municipal sewage sludge, on October 9, 2025, and

**WHEREAS**, Agency staff had projected a thirty percent increase in Agency expenses related to the receipt and disposal of municipal sewage sludge during the development of the 2026 Agency Budget, and

**WHEREAS**, the Agency went out to bid for transportation and disposal of municipal sewage sludge through RFB 2025-05, with bids due back on December 5, 2025, and

**WHEREAS**, the Agency received three bids for municipal sewage sludge transportation and disposal, the lowest of which was 148 dollars per ton, and

**WHEREAS**, in order to avoid further increases to tipping fees paid by other customers, that would be necessary to subsidize municipal sewage sludge, the Board determines it is prudent to increase the tipping fee for municipal sewage sludge to 150 dollars per ton;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that the Agency does hereby amends the 2026 schedule of tipping fees to reflect the increased tipping fee for municipal sewage sludge from 135 dollars per ton to 150 dollars per ton, and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
