Recycling Compliance Report

June 2026

- **I met with Rieber Carting who is a new permitted hauler in Ulster County. I met with them to discuss their lack of recycling in the couple of accounts they are currently servicing and their violation of the Flow Control Law as they have not entered either one of our facilities. After several phone meetings and discussions, they have decided to continue operating in Ulster County. I have collaborated with them to develop a recycling plan, and they will be bringing MSW to our facilities going forward. I will continue to monitor and assist this company to ensure compliance with the laws.**
- **While operating in Pine Bush I noticed that Sonny Zito had an abundance of midsize dumpsters at residential properties without any recycling. I was able to meet with Rich, the owner of the company, to discuss the lack of recycling services and violation of the Mandatory Source Separation**

and Recycling Law regarding these approximately sixty accounts. I gave him a month to contact all these accounts and to implement.

recycling. He is going to offer each resident recycling at \$5 extra a month just to break even.

- American Waste, who is a new Ulster County, permitted hauler will be cancelling their permit as of June 30, 2026, and no longer operating in Ulster County. I will monitor the accounts they were servicing to make sure an Ulster County permitted hauler takes over service.**
- I conducted thirty transfer station Inspections this month. These inspections include taking photo documentation, filling out an inspection sheet, and giving the driver a copy, the data is then put into a spread sheet, and I will mail a copy to the haulers monthly. I will send the haulers a spread sheet with their monthly and daily contamination rates, the dates, times, and truck's license plate numbers.**
- I began investigating summer Camps in the area. Many of these camps are difficult to access but I was able to verify the haulers from the outside of the camps. I will be reaching out to the haulers for support to get recycling established if I am unable to make contact.**

- **This month I will go back to motels in the county. Many of the motels are being utilized as long term housing so they are just as important as multi-family dwellings.**
- **I will continue to monitor and document evidence of haulers not complying with the Flow Control Law and the Mandatory Source Separation Law. I will continue to gather and document evidence that can be used once an administrative law judge is appointed.**
