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Recycling Compliance Report

July 2026

- **Rieber Carting, who is a new permitted hauler, has brought in 17 tons of MSW in two weeks. They have begun their expansion into Ulster County, and I will continue to monitor them as they obtain more accounts in the county to ensure compliance.**
- **Sonny Zito sent out letters to his Ulster County customers on 6/15/2026. This letter informed the customers that recycling is not optional in Ulster County and offered the pickup service for a very reasonable price. This implementation will go into effect on 8/1/2026. I will meet with them before this date to see how many of the approximately 60 accounts added recycling services and monitor their loads at the New Paltz transfer station to ensure that they are not contaminated as they are responsible for what is being dumped into their trucks.**

- I met with SWDS to check in and see how they are operating. They have been compliant with all the laws and have regularly been bringing recycling into our facilities with zero contamination.
- Marc, Nancy, and I met with the new Administrative Hearing Officer, which helped us all get a clear understanding of how these hearings will work, requirements, and evidence needed to hold these haulers accountable. I have documented two Flow Control Violations that I have forwarded to Nancy. I will continue to document these violations every week and forward them to Nancy until these haulers become compliant. I also will be forwarding Mandatory Source Separations violations following my transfer station inspections weekly. My hope is that these inspections along with weekly fines will force the haulers into compliance.
- I conducted thirty transfer station Inspections this month. These inspections include taking photo documentation, filling out an inspection sheet, and giving the driver a copy, the data is then put into a spread sheet, and I will mail a copy to the haulers monthly. I will send the haulers a spread sheet with their monthly and daily contamination rates, the dates, times, and truck's license plate numbers.

- **I had the opportunity to visit many of the summer camps and campgrounds in the County. Many of the summer camps are serviced by Speedy Dumpsters who Ive reached out multiple times to without a response. Marc and I discussed this, and he will try and make contact to get these camps in compliance.**
