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Recycling Compliance Report

August 2026

- **Sonny Zito sent out letters to his Ulster County customers on 6/15/2026.**

This letter informed the customers that recycling is not optional in Ulster County and offered the pickup service for a very reasonable price. As of the deadline date of 8/1/2026 they have 13 out of the 47 Ulster County Customer's implement recycling which is only 28%. After meeting with them they are now going to call every customer and send second letters out as 28% is unacceptable. They also have implemented new policies with their sales team to ensure residents are informed about the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Law and the importance of recycling. It is much easier to get customers to implement both trash and recycling at the time of the purchase of the service. I will be closely monitoring them at the transfer stations on Mondays and Thursdays as they are responsible for the materials being dumped into their trucks.

- **Rieber Carting has made a quick expansion into the County. From 6/29/26 to 8/14/2026 they brought in 70 tons. I have been working with them continuously to get them in compliance with the Mandatory Source Separation Law and getting all their trucks registered.**
- **Marc, Nancy and I have 4 Flow Control Violations ready to be issued for a hearing date scheduled to be 9/26/26. I have documented more violations that will be issued for the following month. My focus is going to be the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Law at the transfer stations to document and issue fines to companies violating the law.**
